## Summer Update 2017 – Twin Rivers Parish Council

**Church Lane:** Following concerns raised by residents we are pleased to advise that chevrons have been placed on the bad bends on Church Lane, Whitgift. We hope this will help to ensure the road is safer.

**Ousefleet Village Hall – picnic benches.** Risk assessments have been carried out and the benches are now in place for everyone to enjoy.

**Ousefleet Village Hall** – Further to the closure of the Hall in December due to health and safety reasons, plans have now been drawn up and registered with East Riding to re-work the toilet layout, sort out the drains, install statutorily required fire doors and disabled access. We hope to have the Hall open, suitable and safe for use (*though perhaps not beautiful just yet*) within a reasonable time frame.

We were successful in a grant application to the Wind Farm to sort out some of the legal issues around the lease etc and again, once confirmation has been received that work will commence forthwith.

Adlingfleet Defebrillator – We have committed to funding 50% of the defibrillator in Adlingfleet, work is on going to secure the remainder.

**Transport for our area** – We have been in discussions with Goole Go Far regarding access to their services – a questionnaire to ascertain need (a minimum of 10) is available to complete to move this forward.

**Website** – We are moving the website and it's on going maintenance and updates to Vision ICT this should happen within the next few months.

**New Councillors and clerk** – We are pleased that Anne Wallace and Stephanie Hampel have joined the team and that Nicola Ingeleton is now our new Parish Clerk.

**Empty/derelict property** – East Riding are working with the owners of the property next to Whitgift Hall (Justice Lane) and the empty house next to the Smithy, in Whitgift to make the areas safe and less unsightly.
