Ousefleet Community Hall. Report from the OVHC committee. Recent meeting minutes had
been circulated. The kitchen is nearly completed with just skirting requiring additional work.

Mr Dargan gave his update as project manager. The toilets require a plumber, electrician and plasterer. The slope requires attention. Mr Dargan will update everyone with the revised project costs. The fire plan by Planman was theoretical and will have to be re-visited. Local contractors have given competitive quotes to get the outside prepared for the plumber.

Playground inspection by ERYC and signage in Ousefleet. The clerk contacted the ERYC officer who was to visit the site.

Visit to Cow Lane by parish councillors is to occur in Spring 2018.

Ideas for Grant applications from Goole Fields. The play area needs fencing. Ideas from residents are welcome and a possible flyer will be prepared in the New Year. The Marshlands Walking Group could be contacted to try and open the riverbank as a complete right of way for everyone to enjoy.
